Welcome to auditions for this McLean Community Players' musical. We would like to take this opportunity to provide you with some basic information on how we operate.

- Be aware that MCP reserves the right to remove any cast member at any time from the production.
- Please be sure to disclose all confirmed or potential schedule conflicts you know of at this time on the tentative rehearsal schedule calendar and hand it in with your audition form. **Any conflicts disclosed after the show is cast will be looked at individually, but could result in dismissal from the production.**

Although we wish we had a huge budget, MCP operates on a shoestring, and asks that you be willing to accept the following:

- Roles in all shows are strictly volunteer -- no cast member will be paid for their performance. Our crew is all-volunteer as well; we're all in this together.
- MCP does not supply general stage make-up or hair products, however we will provide wigs, false facial hair, etc. if required by the director. Make-up and hair advisors will be provided to assist cast members.
- Different musicals call for different types of specific footwear and hosiery. MCP is unable to supply footwear and hosiery to cast members. Productions that require specialty footwear may be arranged by MCP, but may not be provided by MCP. Some cast members will need to wear dance shoes commonly known as Character Shoes. Others may need to wear specific types of street shoes that will work with the costumes and time period of the show. Specific styles and colors of hosiery will also be required.
